Calvary Chapel is on the move

Much like a pregnant woman after nine months of waiting, the members of Cottage Grove's Calvary Chapel celebrated the arrival of the long-awaited day of the first service in their newly remodeled building in the Village Shopping Center. On Sunday, June 14, their dream finally came true. The former Cottage Twin Theater and Plaza Cleaners building now houses a large open sanctuary, a children's wing, offices and a large foyer with coffee bar that can also be used as a meeting space – and most importantly – more bathrooms!

The old adage, "Many hands make for light work," proved true in the remodel-

ing project. Approximately 3000 volunteer hours were invested in a variety of tasks such as design, sheetrock, texture, painting, stained floors, woodwork, murals and more.

Kyle Kishen, a local building contractor, said his biggest challenge was meeting deadlines and coordinating with all the volunteer helpers.

"When working in construction you are always pushing to meet deadlines, sometimes demanding that different trades on a job be finished at a certain time," Kishen said. "When you are working with many volunteers you must always be kind and gracious and accept the effort that is kindly given no matter the outcome."

According to Pastor Jeff Smith, it took roughly nine months from the first day of

clean-up to the first service and approximately \$180,000 in materials and some professional labor. He said there is more to be done and the other areas will be completed as the Lord provides the funds.

"It was a happy adventure working with Kyle, who is a faithful multi-task servant; and we are all thankful there is no debt or loans to pay off," Smith said.

He noted the significance of living under limited resources for so long and how the new facility will give Calvary Chapel the capability to fulfill its purpose of reaching all generations.

"While the practical things will be important: more seating, better parking, easy accessibility from I-5, central location
