Since the late 1800s the local Presbyterians have been serving up ice cream for special occasions each summer.

In 1959, they had their annual summer ice cream social coincide with the Bohemia Mining Days Festival. This year's social features home-made cakes, brownies and pies and a choice of ice cream flavor. The church is located on the corner of Adams Avenue and South Third Street. BMD Chuckwagon Breakfast – Saturday, July 18 from 7-10 a.m.

tival. The menu is half BBQ chicken, baked beans, coleslaw, buttered roll, cookie and beverage. Cost: \$7.50 per plate or \$6.50 for chicken only. Proceeds from this year's fundraiser will go to the Trinity Lutheran Scholarship Fund and the Family Relief Nursery. Plan to go early as this popular BMD event often sells out of chicken before the planned 7 p.m. ending time. Trinity Lutheran Church is located on the corner of Quincy Avenue and South Sixth Street. The BMD Express Train provides free service to the church between noon-5:30 p.m.
