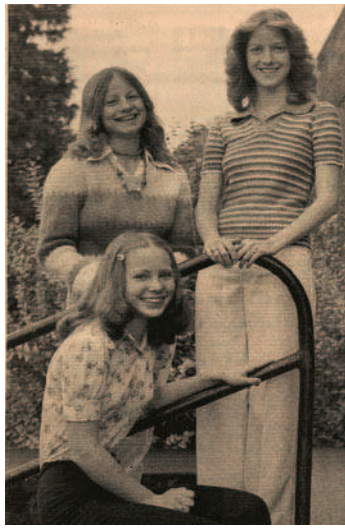
A look back at Sentinel stories from 30 and 60 years ago

Nov. 1, 1945

Lions win league title

The Cottage Grove Lions captured the Tri-County league lead last Friday by defeating a tough Roseburg team 21-0. Coach Dusenberry's charges, led by the Lions' driving fullback Noel Campbell, who scored all three touchdowns for the Lions, rolled up 290 net yards and 15 first downs to the Indians' 80 net yards and eight

first downs. The Lions, in their usual manner, scored early in the first period to get the jump on a bewildered Indian eleven. The Indians received the kickoff but found the CG line too tough and were forced to kick on third down. The Lions promptly started a drive that climaxed when Noel Campbell circled his right end and ran 40 yards for the touchdown. Newton ran left end for the conversion. The first period ended 7-0 for the Lions.
