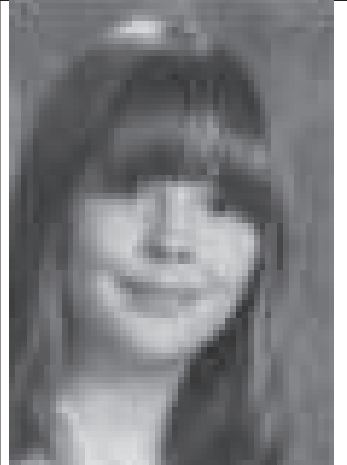
**NADIA WITT**

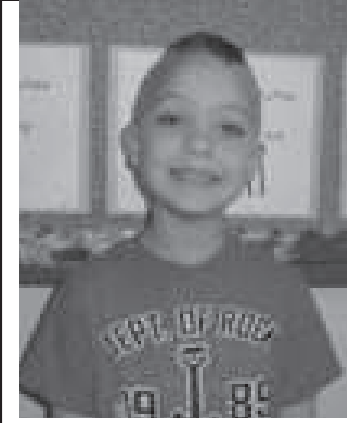

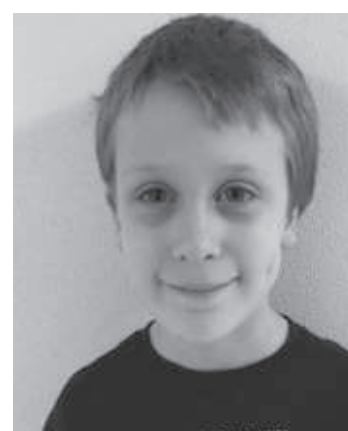
