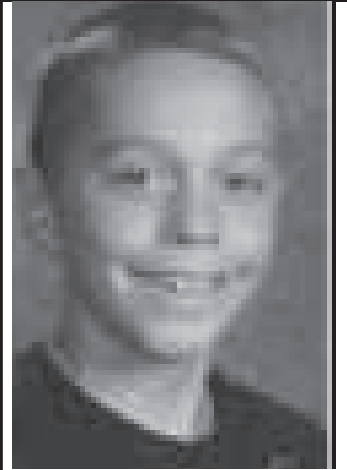
Zoe is in Mrs. Christianson's KG/1st grade class at London School. She is always helpful and

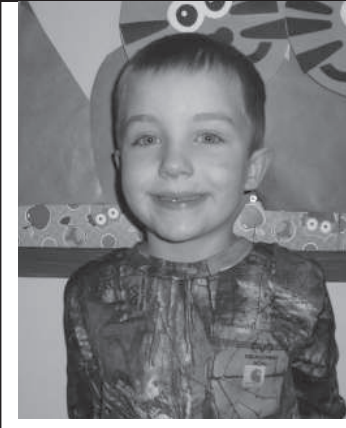

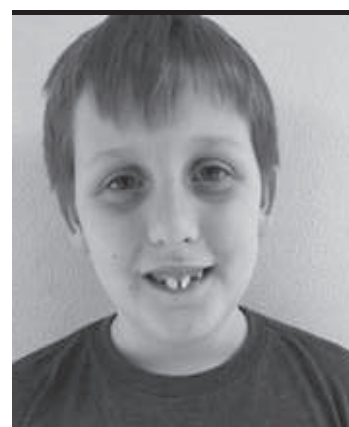
SAWYER BLACK
