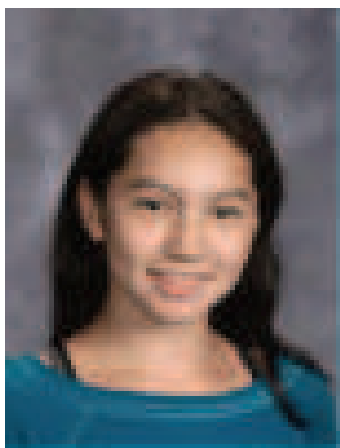
## Exemplary Students

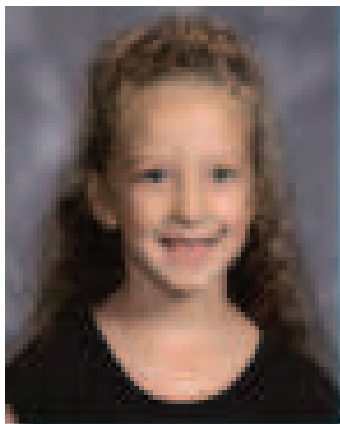
**Zoe Goings**
