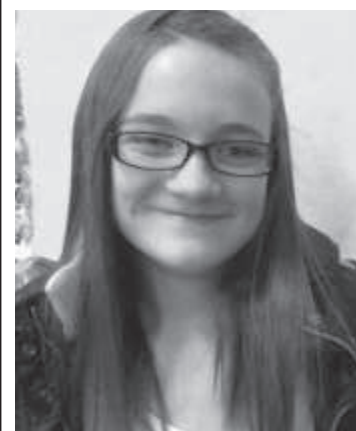


**DESTANIE HUMES**

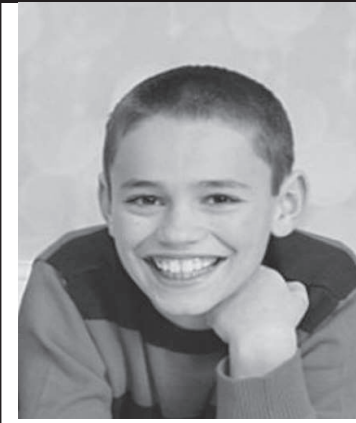


**KENNEDY UMBARGER**
