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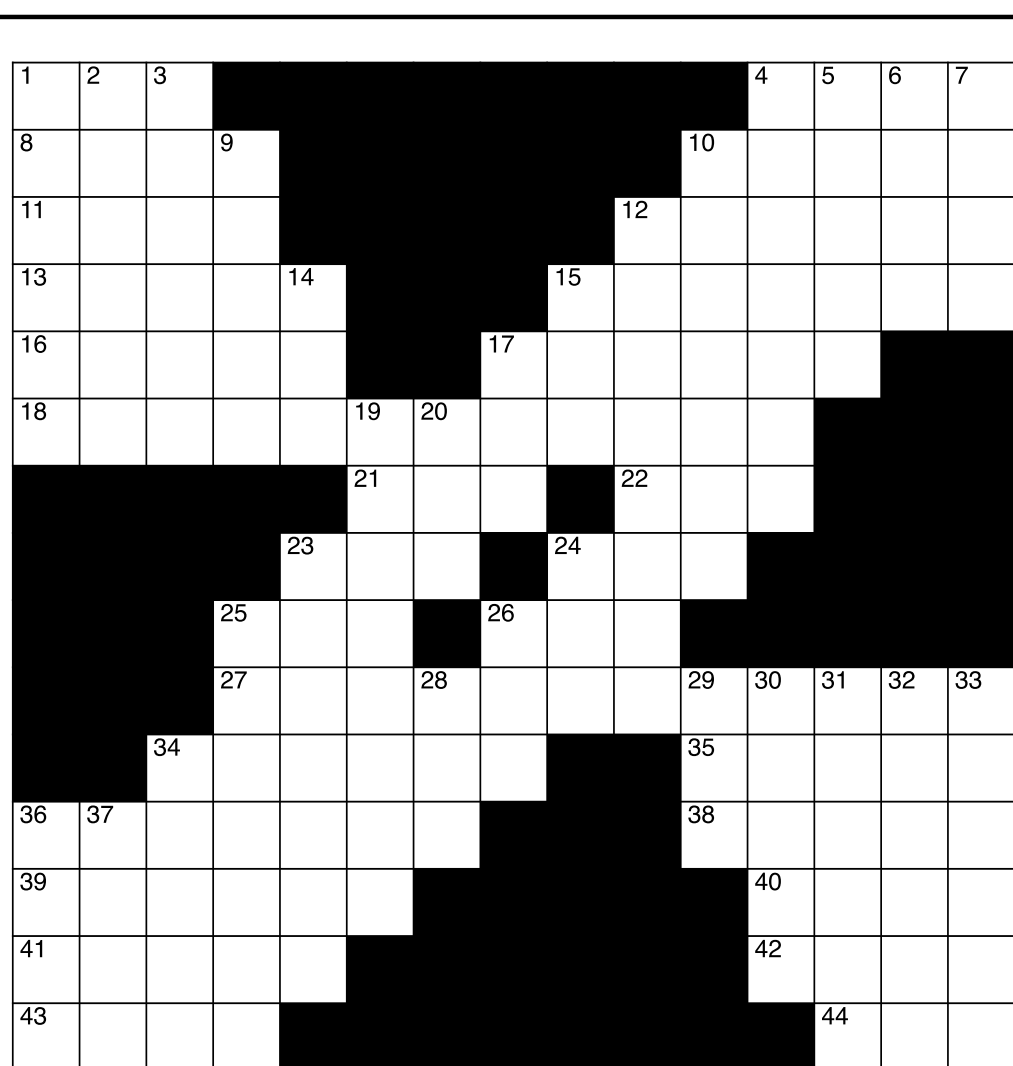

The Reserve for Future Expenditures in the Equipment Reserve Fund is \$2,710,700.00.
