took all of the special awards in the All-League roster (Coach of the Year, Player of the Year and Pitcher of the Year).

Head Coach Dan Geiszler was voted Coach of the Year, which usually comes with winning a league title in most sports. But Geiszler's strategy proved to be a major key in the Lions' success. Aggressive base running put Cottage Grove in scoring position very frequently, and as of now, they hold over 100 stolen bases on the season.

Brett Ollivant was named pitcher of the year. Ollivant held an ERA of 1.79 as the starting pitcher for most games. He

holds a win percentage of 85.7 along with one shutout. Ollivant also has over 40 strikeouts on the season.

Player of the Year went to Payton Presley, the Lions' top hitter. Presley currently holds a team-high batting average of .524 and 24 RBIs. The senior second baseman has totaled over 45 hits, two doubles, one triple and two home runs. Presley also has a 90.2 fielding percentage off of 112 chances this season.

The Lions enter the playoffs ranked at fourth in the state. Their first game will be tonight (Wednesday, May 25) against Baker/Powder Valley at home.
