 To: All interested Agencies include all interested Agencies, FEMA, HUD, City of Yoncalla, Douglas County, Oregon. Groups and Individuals

This is to give notice that the City of Yoncalla has conducted an evaluation as required by Executive Order 11988 and 11990, in accordance with HUD regulations at 24 CFR 55.20 Subpart C Procedures for Making Determinations on Floodplain Management, to determine the potential affect that its activity in the floodplain and wetland will have on the human environment for **The City of Yoncalla Wastewater System Improvement Project.** The project is for the construction of a new influent pump station and force main that conveys flow from the City of Yoncalla to the City's wastewater treatment lagoons. The new piping replaces the existing undersized wastewater collection system and prevents sanitary sewer overflows.

The project will include wastewater collection improvements and effluent disposal improvements; a new influent pump station, new force main that conveys wastewater to the lagoon treatment system, an effluent outfall pipe and initial infrastructure for a future recycled water irrigation system.

The City of Yoncalla proposes construction of a new influent pump station (at a new location) that utilizes three new submersible pumps, a new control building, a new power generator,
