Lane Community College Eugene-area locations, including its main campus, will close on Fridays for the summer beginning Friday, June 24 and continuing through Friday, Aug. 26. No services will be available, and no classes or events will be held unless otherwise scheduled by a department or program.

Officer-involved shooting

On Tuesday, June 14 at about 3:06 p.m., Douglas County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a report of a disturbance with shots fired at 2306 Happy Valley Road in Roseburg.

When Deputies arrived, they say they found a 19-year old female in the driveway who had been shot. The shooter was re-

ported to be on foot in the area. Law enforcement officers from all around Douglas County responded to the incident.

While attending to the injured woman, the suspect fired a shot at the law enforcement officers who returned fire. The suspect was later found to be deceased. Preliminary indication at the scene is that the male suspect died from an apparent self-inflicted gunshot wound.

The Douglas County Major Crimes Team is investigating the incident with the Oregon State Police being the lead investigative agency.

The female was transported to Mercy Medical Center and later transferred via Air Ambulance to Sacred Heart at Riverbend in Springfield and is expected to survive.

Campground reopening

Lane County, the United States Forest Service (USFS) and Oregon State Parks hosted a grand opening ceremony on Friday, June 17 to mark the reopening of the Archie Knowles Campground and Day Use Area.

An \$84,976 grant from the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department and a \$58,838 grant from the Siuslaw National Forest made the rehabilitation of the park possible, and an agreement with the USFS will allow Lane County to manage the 4.5-acre site into the future. Reopening the campground has been a priority of area residents since the camp was closed by the United States Forest Service in 2012.

Archie Knowles Campground was named for a former Forest Service ranger who was the child of early area settlers Albert and Lillian Knowles.

Curtin stabbing

On Thursday, June 16 at approximately 11 p.m., Douglas County Emergency Communications said it received a report of a stabbing that occurred in the 1400 block of Curtin Road in Curtin.

Sheriff's Office Deputies and officers from the Sutherlin Po-

lice Department responded to the scene, where they contacted 42-year old David Weinholt and 32-year old Regina Augdon of Curtin. Weinholt reported he suffered a stab wound from 51-year old Kevin Grant Ray during a confrontation where they began to fight. During the altercation, Kevin Ray also allegedly stabbed Weinholt in the chest. Police say Ray fled the scene prior to the arrival of emergency responders.

Medics transported Weinholt to River Bend Hospital in Eugene. He is expected to survive.

Law enforcement officers conducted a search of the area and were unable to locate Ray. If anyone has any information in regards to the whereabouts of Kevin Ray, they are encouraged to contact the Douglas County Sheriff's Office at 541-440-4471.
