### **Swift Fly-In Antique Aircraft Display**

Be sure to look up when you hear the buzz of vintage aircraft flying around town during BMD. The Oregon Aviation Historical Society hosts the Swift Fly-In this weekend and invites festival-goers to visit its newly remodeled museum at the Cottage Grove Airport.

On Saturday morning, 10-15 Swift pilots begin the day with an aerial tour and will fly over the Grand Miners Parade about 10:15 for the enjoyment of parade watchers.

The Globe Swift was one of the first of the new planes to appear in 1946 after WWII. A group of young engineers in Denton, Texas applied their fighter plane experience to design a small modern all aluminum airplane with retractable landing gear and a hydraulic system. Of the 1100 Swifts produced from 1946-51, about 500 are still flying. Don't miss this opportunity to enjoy these vintage aircraft and learn more about Oregon's unique aviation history.

Back by popular demand, Aaron's Amusements allows festival-goers of all ages to channel their inner cowboy/cowgirl and take a ride on its mechanical bull.

### **Hit and Miss Engine Display**

Keeping with this year's festival theme, you will be greeted inside the main entrance by a working display of early twentieth century "hit and miss" engines, which were well-used in Cottage Grove's early history.

These early gasoline/kerosene/fuel oil powered stationary engines ran home appliances such as a washing machine, powered electric generators, belt driven mills and workshops.

Located in the Heritage Area near Adams Avenue.
