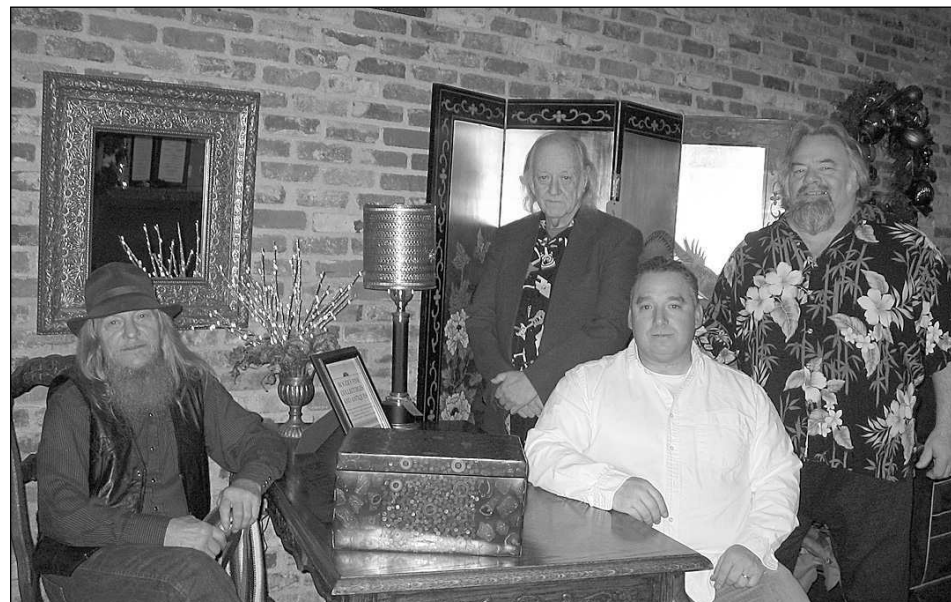
BMD welcomes back Cowboy Cadillac to the Main Stage on Sunday at noon
