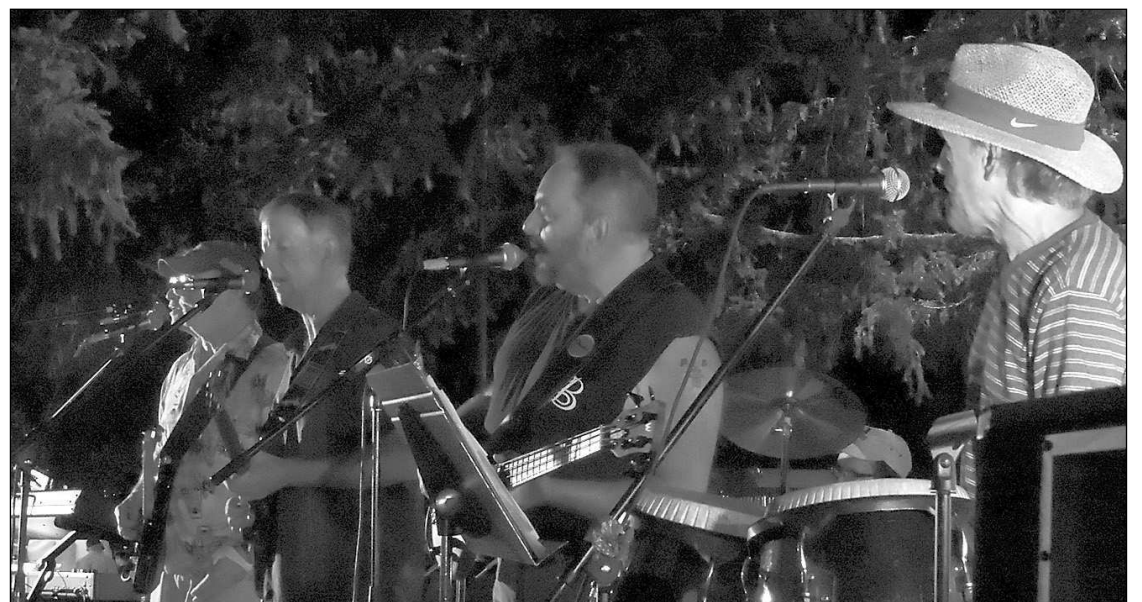
The band’s signature musical style blends Rock, Blues, Country and a little jazz.
