SECTION A - ANNUALS

Lot 1 - Asters, Giant, 1 bloom

Lot 2 - Begonias, fibrous–3 stems rooted

Lot 3 - Cosmos, 3 blooms

Lot 4 - Marigolds, Large/medium,1 bloom
French or dwarf, 3 sprays
