CLASS 6 - GARDEN CRAFT

- A. Collage**
- 1. A two-dimensional abstract design done on a flat panel or board. Cut or torn materials are glued, pasted or otherwise attached.
- 2. A minimum of low relief plant materials, fresh and/or dried, are used.
- 3. Found objects are not required but may be used. They must be flat, not three-dimensional.

4. Apparent visual depth is obtained by overlapping planes and juxtaposition of color, pattern and/or texture

These will be hung on the wall.

C. Herbarium (Plant Scrapbook)

Use two sheets of 8 1/2 x 11” paper for each plant. Mount dried and pressed plants on one page. Use second page for description. This will make two facing pages to be placed in plastic protectors and will be displayed on the wall.
