Suspected counterfeiters arrested

Since late July of 2016, the Douglas County Sheriff's Office has been receiving information of counterfeit \$100 bills being passed in various locations in Douglas County.

The Sheriff's Office Detectives Division began an investigation into the information, and during the investigation developed information that 36-year old Corey R. Roland of Glide, along with others, was involved in the production and passing of the bills.

On Aug. 15, the Sheriff's Office served a search warrant at Corey Roland's residence, located in the 200 Block of Estella, Glide. Contacted at the residence at the time the warrant was served was; Corey Roland, 27-year

old Cory L. Williams of Idlewild Park, and 25-year old Rochelle M. Claughton of Glide.

Sheriff's Detectives located and seized numerous items from the residence that they say related to the investigation. Also seized were narcotics.

All three subjects were arrested and lodged at the Douglas County Jail.

The Sheriff's Office Detectives are in contact with the United States Secret Service, and more arrests from the investigation are expected.
