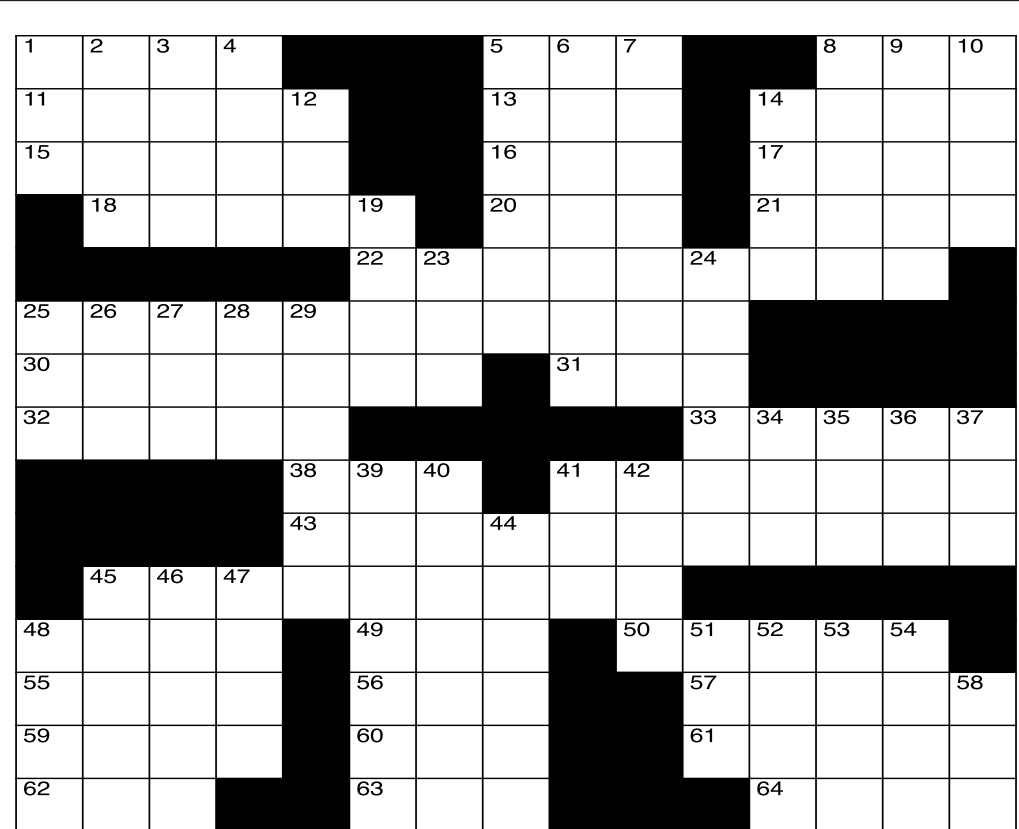

Request for Release of Funds:
 On or about April 1, 2017 the above-named entity will submit a request to the Oregon Business Development Department (OBDD) for the release federal Community Development Block Grant funds under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (Pl. 93-383), as amended, to undertake a project known as:

Project Title: PUMP STATION IMPROVEMENTS

Purpose of Nature/scope of project: Relocate the Influent Pump Station (IPS) to the southeast corner of the intersection of Eagle Valley Road and Halo Trail Road. Construct a new 10-inch diameter force main from the new pump Station to the inlet structure at the head of the treatment lagoon. Replace the existing inlet structure with a manual bar screen. Add a second north/south lagoon inter-connection pipe. Construct the base infrastructure for recycled water irrigations system. Improvements include a recycled water wet well and recycled water force main extending to Halo Trail Road.

Estimated funding: \$2,389,000 CDBG

The legal effect of the certification is, upon its approval, the City of Yoncalla may use the Grant funds, and OBDD will have satisfied its responsibilities under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 and related laws and authorities.

 OBDD will accept objections to its Release of Funds and the City of Yoncalla certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or actual receipt of the request for release of funds (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases:

- B. The City of Yoncalla has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58
