FIREWOOD ADVERTISING LAW

Oregon Dept. of Agriculture requires a cord be stacked and measure 128 cubic ft. i.e. 8x4x4 or 2x8x8 etc. =128.

Ads must also identify the species of wood and whether the wood is unseasoned (green) or dry.
