

Last play of the year for HS

CG student awarded **Northwest Community** scholarship

Erin Foreman awarded \$1,000 for tuition, books

Northwest Community Credit Union has awarded 22 scholarships to students throughout Oregon who have demonstrated dedication to creating a positive impact in their community. Local student, Erin Foreman was awarded \$1,000 for displaying a "dedication to displaying a positive change" in her community. According to an announcement detailing the winners of the award, Foreman plans to attend George Fox University in the fall after graduating from Cottage Grove High School.

Scholarships will be dispersed for the 2017-18 school year and range in value from \$1,000 to \$5,000.

"Education is crucial for strong local communities. We're committed to helping students throughout Oregon pay for college," said Northwest Community Credit Union's CEO John Iglesias. "These scholarships give the receiving students a chance to follow their dreams and help alleviate the financial burden of pursuing a degree."

Northwest Community Credit Union received more than 90 scholarship applications. Winners include students new to higher education and

continuing students. Scholarship recipients hail from Lane, Benton, Coos, Douglas, Deschutes, Jackson, Multnomah and Harney counties in Oregon.

Two scholarship categories are awarded each year. The Larry Levine Memorial Scholarship honors writer and Assistant Professor Larry Levine, who was killed along with eight Umpqua Community College students in 2015. The scholarship is awarded to Douglas County residents attending Umpqua Community College and covers tuition, books and fees up to \$5,000 for the 2017-18 school year. Jenna Anderson of Winchester, Oregon and Samantha Winters of Roseburg, Oregon are this year's recipients.

The second category—the Northwest Community Scholarship—awards \$1,000 to students

who demonstrate a dedication to creating a positive impact in their community. Twenty recipients will attend institutions such as Oregon State University, University of Oregon, Lewis and Clark College, Corban University, University of California, Davis and American University, among
