

Crockett, Mayden, and Scott Claim Sunday May 28th Victories at Cottage Grove

Cottage Grove, Oregon-Sunday, May 28th would be the second and final leg of the 2017 Marvin Smith Memorial Grove Classic. There would be even more cars in the pit area with all three divisions being swollen with very good car counts. The 360 Sprints division was back for their second straight evening while the Mohawk Metals IMCA Modifieds and Quality RV Repair Hornets returned to the ¼-mile clay oval.

Chris Schmelzle, of Colville, Washington, took advantage of his pole starting position to lead the field on the opening lap. Lap two would witness Roger Crockett make it past Schmelzle to seize first place. Crockett, of Medford and in the Roger Henderson machine, would then battle with Jason Solwold

for quite some time.

Solwold, from Burlington, Washington in the Mike Anderson and Monica Bata owned mount, would obtain the lead on lap four only to lose the position to Crockett on lap eleven. 
