On Dec. 16, 1950, Catherine and Wilbur were married at the Cottage Grove Catholic Church.

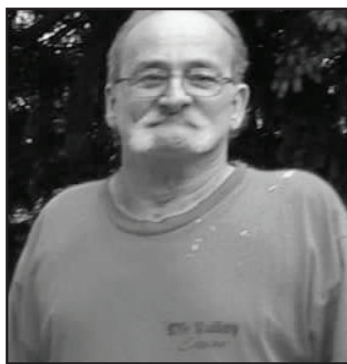
They were blessed with two sons: Craig and Jeffry as well as two grandchildren. She was pre-

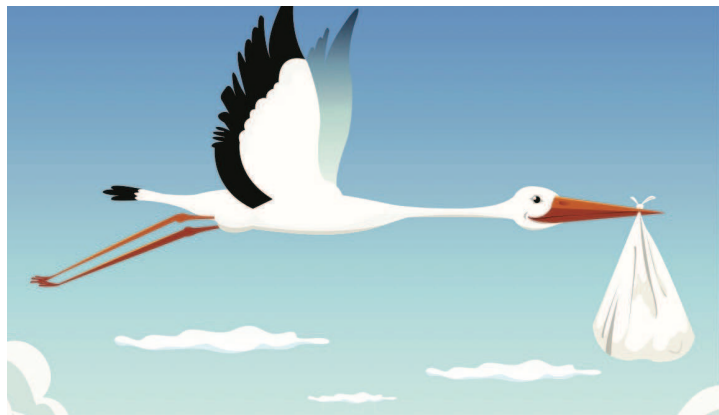
