

# Update from Dorena School for October

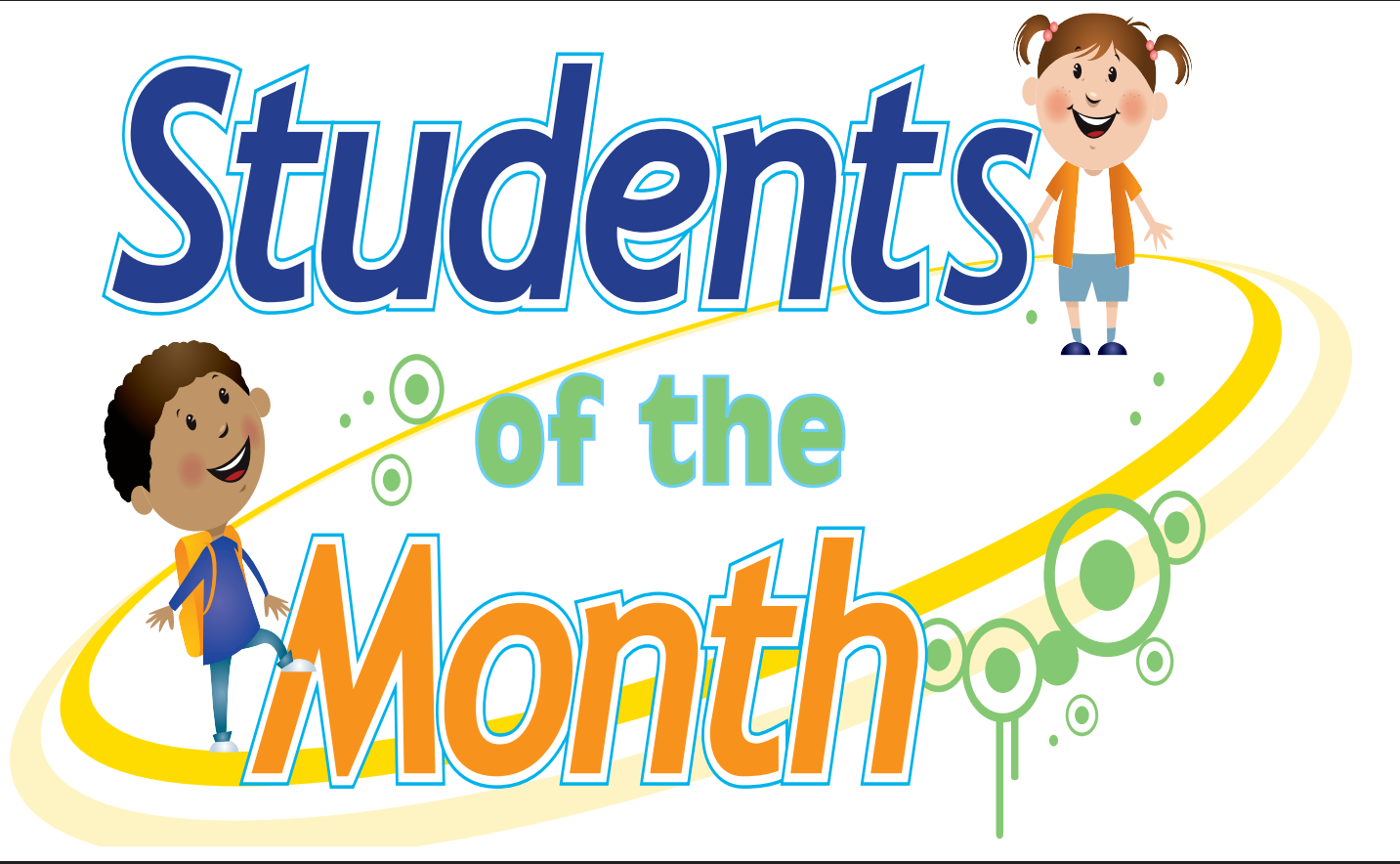
