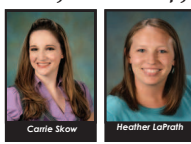

Elkton's Trentyn Halstead scored Elkton's only touchdown of the game in the second quarter on a seven yard run.

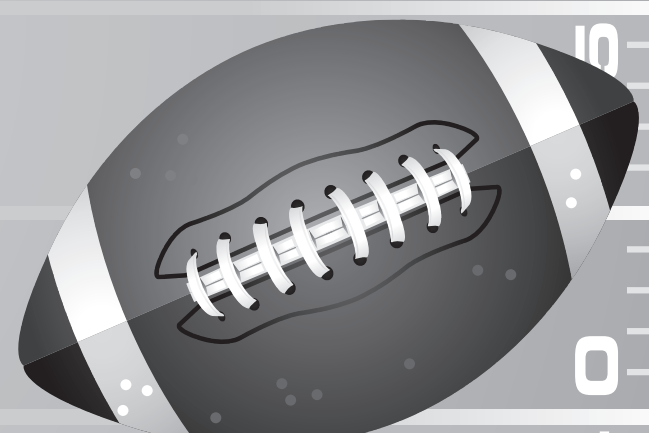
Yoncalla Fotoball
