

# 76th anniversary of Pearl Harbor

A look back at coverage from 1941

The following was printed in the Sentinel on Dec. 11, 1941.

About 150 attended a civilian defense meeting held at the city hall Tuesday evening. The purpose of the meeting was twofold; namely to work out a plan whereby the mill owners can, if necessary, extinguish burner fires and to work out a coordinated blackout alarm for both the urban and rural residents. In referring to the necessity of complete cooperation among all residents, Major Metcalf stressed the need of complete cooperation of people in all districts. He said: "The enemy can easily become familiar with the contour of the country and if the blackout is not complete, might easily follow lights up or down the valley until he came to a blackout. The black spot would be a tell-tale clue and the enemy might blast it simply by throwing out a flare and circling."

Practically every mill owner in this section attended and pledged 100 percent cooperation in the matter of extinguishing fires in burners; however, the matter of extinguishing fires in this respect is not an easy problem since it would shut the mill down for the following day. Mill owners agreed to work out

plans to extinguish burner fires on short notice, but details of the plan were not announced.

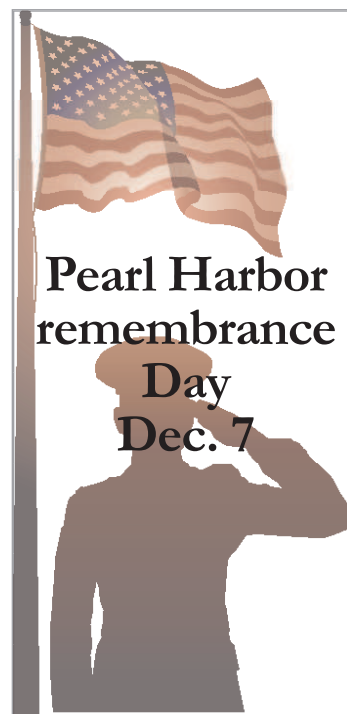
Woodard Offers Siren Use. W.A. Woodard of the Woodard Lumber company, has offered to use a loud siren which will be operated from the boiler room at the Woodard mill, to sound a general alarm. This siren can be heard for several miles and is the most effective means of spreading a general alarm. Under the present plan

all alarms will be given out from the city police. Alarms will be relayed from the Eugene filter center to local police who will arrange to call one mill in each locality of this section. The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph company will cooperate by making connections to the various communities but will not assume any responsibility for false alarms.

Spotter Station Manned. The local airplane spotter

station at the top of the Cottage Grove hotel has been manned continuously since the U.S.-Jap difficulty. Spotters work in two hour shifts and the shifts are so arranged that a new spotter comes on every hour. The station is manned by two spotters. The ladies work from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and the men the remainder of the period.

Ray Nelson, assistant in charge of the station, reports that the general public apparently do not know that this precaution is being taken here.
