Rogue River outlasts Yoncalla

After an offensive explosion in the first quarter by both teams, it was Rogue River outlasting Yoncalla for a 41-29 victory on Tuesday night at Yoncalla High School.

The Eagles fast start saw the team score over half of their

points, 16, in the opening quarter. It started with Shanausi Hardy getting back-to-back buckets out of the same offensive set; one time she found herself open for a reverse lay-up and the next possession pulled up from 12-feet out and found the bottom of the net.

Hardy, who finished the game with 10 points, added a three as did teammates Kaleigh Soto and Kenzie Walton. Jamie Glenn joined in on the fun as she scored four of her 10 points in the quarter.

Their early lead and offensive outpouring was short-lived. The Eagles had six field goals in the first quarter and had six field goals for the rest of the game.

"As they gain legs you know they'll be able to get their endurance for the game and stuff like that. You can see that we just kind of tucker out right there in the second, third quarter," said Yoncalla head coach Nicolas Edera.

"But when we learn to move

the ball we'll start helping ourselves and it will allow us to rest a little on offense instead we like to jack up the first shot and it turns into YMCA basketball and we're running back and forth up and down the court."

Rogue River stayed competitive in the first quarter as they hit two threes of their own (neither team hit a three-pointer after the first quarter) and at the end of one trailed 16-13. As offensive production for both teams dried up in the second quarter, Yoncalla scored two points and Rogue River six, the Chieftains took a lead and never

looked back.

Propelled by Jaydin Spaeth's 12 points on the game, eight in the second half, the Chieftains got their lead up to eight in the third quarter and a 6-0 run in the fourth squashed any inklings of an Eagles comeback.

"I just like the way they fight. They're tough and they go at it hard for four quarters and as long as they want to do that we can live that way as a basketball team," said Edera. "We'll gain a lot through the years and like I said we started two freshman, a sophomore, a junior and a senior. We're really young."

Cottage Grove football honored

While the season wrapped up with a championship over a month ago, the awards keep

coming in for the Cottage Grove football team.

Last Wednesday it was announced that the Lions swept the biggest 4A awards winning offensive and defensive player of the year along with head coach Gary Roberts being named coach of the year for the second year in a row. On the offensive side it was wide receiver Jacob Woods being honored and on the defense it was linebacker Cooper Ladd getting the nod.

Additionally, the Lions saw six players recognized for being first team all-state on offense:
