The Lions are currently in fourth place. The top three teams in the league automatically qualify for playoffs. The fourth team is eligible for an at-large bid.





Last Friday at the Stayton Twilight Meet, Cottage Grove's Jacob Woods stole the show.

Woods scored 26 points by himself at the meet finishing first in the 200 and second in both the 100 and long jump.

For perspective, if he had competed as his own team, he would have finished in 11th of the 21 teams in the team competition; one spot ahead of Junction City. This was in addition to anchoring the 4 x 100 team that featured Hayden Glenn, Cooper Ladd and Juice Claflin to a third-place finish.
