potential residents of Cottage Village would include low-income individuals who earn less than 50 percent of the area's median income and may include people who are current couch surfing, seniors with fixed incomes, individuals who are currently living in cars and single parents or veterans.

Residents of the village will also take part in its governance, according to SquareOne and maintain the property. They will also be required to perform at least 10 hours of volunteer work and attend a monthly meeting with fellow residents. All residents will undergo a background check; must provide proof they are able to make monthly payments and two references.

While no structure in the village is planned to be larger than 300 square feet, there will be different models incorporated into the community.

"Each unit has its own bathroom and shower, and small kitchen. The size of these homes make them very energy efficient. The village will also include a community center complete with a gathering space, commercial kitchen, library, workshop space and more," a statement from Cottage Village Coalition read. The property currently has an existing house that was refurbished by SquareOne and, according to Kelsh, currently houses a family who had been living separately because the cost of rent in Cottage Grove was too high.

"The tiny houses proposed for Cottage Village are part of a larger national movement to create efficient, low-cost housing for low income residents squeezed by high rents and low availability of rental units," Cottage Village Coalition wrote, "especially in rural communities like Cottage Grove."

Garden Club to offer presentation on constructing, caring for water gardens

A small water garden on a patio or deck provides a focal point and a sense of tranquility. And the best part is that it can't be overwatered.

Plus, water gardens do not need weeding and, with the right balance of plants and water, they are relatively maintenance free.

On Tuesday, June 5, the Cottage Grove Garden Club will welcome Faye Forhan, past president of the Oregon Koi and Water Garden Society, and owner of two koi ponds along with several water gardens.

Valdez to speak on 'Finding Home' at next CG Genealogical Society meeting

The Cottage Grove Genealogical Society is presenting Kathy Corey Valdez, who will speak at its program on Wednesday, June 13, in the Shepard Room beginning at 11 a.m.

The title of her talk will be "Finding My Way Home — An

Adventure to Ancestral Places in Ireland and England."

Valdez was born in Eugene, on St. Patrick's Day, and began delving into family history shortly before retirement in 2013 after 37 years as a teacher.

At the time, her father researched their Irish family

records (pre-Internet) and discovered records were essentially non-existent. Valdez took up her father's cause, deciding to make Ireland her focus.

Six years of rigorous research has led her to discover living Irish cousins.

"You can be sure Dad was with me every step of the way," said Valdez, who has presented at Ancestry Detectives in Silverton, the Genealogical Forum of Oregon in Portland, and the Willamette Valley Genealogical Society in Salem.

The June presentation is free and open to the public.
