South Lane Transportation Safety campaign begins July 30

The community is invited to attend a meeting July 30, beginning at 6:30 p.m. at the Cottage Grove Community Cenyer (700 Gibbs St.), during which South Lane Transportation (SLT) will be sharing information about what the county is doing to improve safety.

It will showcase three safety projects on Row River Road, London Road and Sears Road.

There will also be a kids' activity table, free bike helmet raffle, light refreshments and general safety information.

SLT has secured additional grant funding and will be able to complete the remaining crossing improvements envisioned by the Row River Trail Corridor Plan that was adopted by the Lane County Board of Commissioners in 2013.

In 2015, SLT was able to construct two trail crossing safety improvements: an undercrossing at milepost 4.0; and an improved alignment with signage and lighting at milepost 5.4.

As early as summer 2019, SLT hopes to be able to im-

prove the crossings of the Row River Trail and Row River Road at mileposts 0.75 and 11.0.

Remember to observe fireworks safety restrictions

June 23 marked the opening of the season for fireworks sales in Oregon. Legal fireworks can be purchased only from Oregon permitted fireworks retailers and stands.

Oregon law prohibits possession, use or sale of any firework that fly into the air, explode or travel more than 12 feet horizontally on the ground, without a permit issued by the OSFM.

Fireworks commonly called bottle rockets, Roman candles and firecrackers are illegal in Oregon without a permit.

All fireworks are prohibited on all Oregon beaches, in state parks and campgrounds and on all federal public lands.

Officials can seize illegal fireworks and charge offenders with a class B misdemeanor which could result in a fine of up to \$2,500 per violation and a civil penalty of up to \$500.
