Dancers with and without disabilities create collaborative work over the course of a nine-month season for projects in Lane County and beyond. This is an opportunity to be a part of a creative team with a world-renowned choreographer leading the way.

DanceAbility performances in events such as school community assemblies, gatherings, formal concerts and showcases as well as site specific work in the form of "informances" which activate the community in regards to issues about society's assumptions about disability.

Attorney General leads group of 29 to file comments with Federal Trade Commission

SALEM — Monday, Ore-Rosenblum led a bipartisan group of 29 Attorneys General in filing comments with the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) highlighting the significant role State Attorneys General play in consumer protection, and asking the FTC to include their viewpoint and expertise as the agency holds public hearings on "Competition and Consumer Protection in the 21st Century."

In June, the FTC announced the agency will hold a series of public hearings, "on

whether broad-based changgon Attorney General Ellen es in the economy, evolving business practices, new technologies, or international developments might require adjustments to competition and consumer protection enforcement law, enforcement priorities, and policy."

> The FTC asked interested parties to submit comments by Aug. 20.

> "The FTC plays a pivotal role in the development and enforcement of regulations that protect consumers. Almost everything we do today has a digital footprint, and the FTC is relied upon to

help ensure we have strong systems in place to protect our personal information and data" said Rosenblum.

In the comments, the State Attorneys General speak to the broad role they have as consumer protectors in their states and the concerns they share, particularly as they pertain to privacy and internet security.

The comments continue, "In our experiences, consumer privacy and data security is an afterthought in product and service development," read part of the joint statement.

The comments filed today were led by Rosenblum, and also joined by the Attorneys General of Arizona, Arkansas, California, Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Hawaii, Illinois, Iowa, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, Minnesota, Mississippi, Nebraska, New Mexico, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Tennessee, Virginia, Vermont, Washington, and Washington, D.C.

calculated using the city's tax revenue—if it were to be made public—and the city's tax rate, as well as the 17

In this year's unaudited budget, the city of Cottage Grove lists marijuana tax revenue as being budgeted at \$15,000. In the 2016-2017 budget, the city

collected \$11,484 in marijuana sales tax. In Monday night's report, the Department of Revenue did release the amount of money distributed to cities as \$10,072,791.68. The city op-

erates on a fiscal year while the agency responsible for distributing the funds from the state operates on a calendar year.



Burback said he was familiar with some of the individuals running for his seat in November and noted that he was recently asked in jest what he would do when he lost. "I'll be pulling more weeds


in my yard," he replied.
