percent.” He also said that volunteers who were given clicker counters at the gates were overwhelmed with the crowds.

“Short of blowing up drone footage and counting little dots as people, and I don't think Guinness will accept that as proof alone...,” Palmer said.

While Cottage Grove did not break the record, Palmer lauded the amount of press coverage the event received as part of his report to the council which comes on the heels of the chamber receiving funds from the city each year, in part through the transient room tax.

“I spent half a day with a reporter from the *LA Times*,” he said. “NPR was talking about it nationally.”

Counting systems weren't the only problem during the

Aug. 18 attempt. While the chamber had planned on 15 taps to serve beer, only five were operational, leading to long beer lines and the event, which was cash only, saw its ATM machines malfunction.

As a result, the chamber is selling left over merchandise at its office.

“This was a big risk for us,” Palmer said, informing

the council that the original idea behind the event came with a \$50,000 price tag that soon grew to \$112,000.

Eventually, the chamber agreed to a figure closer to \$75,000 that Palmer said he decreased even further.

“There are still numbers out there and we're still getting invoices but we're fairly certain that we're in the black,” he said.

The toga party was aimed at celebrating the anniversary of the film “Animal House” that had scenes filmed in Cottage Grove 40 years ago. Several scenes took place in the armory as well as on Main Street.

When asked if it would become an annual event, Palmer quickly said no.

Instead, he said it may be a 10-year event, but noted that the individuals who either appeared in the movie themselves or had their band's songs played, may not be able to continue in planned celebrations.

“I don't know how many years Otis has in him,” Palmer said in regards to a musician associated with the film who attended the Aug. 18 party.

Palmer continuously noted that, while the city didn't break the record, it has accomplished other feats.

“A lot of people think Cottage Grove is a small town with small events and small minds and we proved them wrong,” he said. “I think we opened the hearts and minds of people.”
