LCSO conducts enforcement to reduce crashes, fatalities

The Lane County Sheriff's Office (LCSO) is using special allocated funding from the Oregon Department of Transportation and the Oregon State Sheriffs' Association to provide overtime patrols with a focus on Traffic and Life Safety through the Labor Day weekend.

LCSO deputies have logged more than 30 hours of grant-funded overtime patrols so far, focusing on seat belt use, speeding, distracted driving and DUII detection and apprehension. LCSO wants to remind motorists to buckle up, drive safely and drive sober. With the passage of Oregon's marijuana laws, this is also a reminder of the impairment marijuana has on drivers, impacting the ability to safely operate a motor vehicle.

Driving Under the Influence of Intoxicants (DUII) applies to drivers under the influence of marijuana, as it does with alcohol.
