

Coast Fork Willamette Watershed council to host movie night

On Tuesday, Sept. 25, the Coast Fork Willamette Watershed Council will show the documentary film "The Lost Fish: The Struggle to Save Pacific Lamprey," by Freshwaters Illustrated.

The film "explores the connection between the Pacific Lamprey and the people of the Columbia River System.

The film documents the determined efforts of several Columbia Basin Tribes to restore this sacred fish to their ancestral waters, and captures

the passion and spirit of those working on behalf of lamprey, including Nez Perce elder and Lamprey Champion, Elmer Crow Jr.

been spent, with the bulk of that for Harrison.

With a matching bond grant from the Oregon State Legislature of \$4 million, the district has an estimated \$12.1 million remaining. As of now, an estimated \$6.2 million of that funding has been set aside for the modernization of the aquatic center.

"The really important part is we've been very good stewards of the funds," said interim superintendent Larry Sullivan. "We have accomplished a lot of things and still have money left which can go a long way in meeting the ex-

pectations of the community."

violate the law. Sure enough, like other states across the nation, Oregon cities have faced such lawsuits in our recent past."

Meyers' suggestion to the council to repeal the code

also cited the City's periodic review of provisions of the municipal code that may not comply with state and federal law.

While Meyers noted the city hasn't issued citations to individuals under 9.20.020, panhandling within city limits has been enforced

through municipal code 10.30.010; a traffic ordinance.

Under the ordinance, no exchange of items in the roadway can take place, effectively barring drivers from passing items, such as food or money, to individuals panhandling on the

street.

However, the ordinance does not cover private property such as restaurants.

The council completed the first vote.

The ordinance repealing the code cannot be adopted at a single meeting.
