Seth is a teacher and Macky is a family nurse practitioner. They plan to continue living in Eugene after honeymooning in Hawaii.



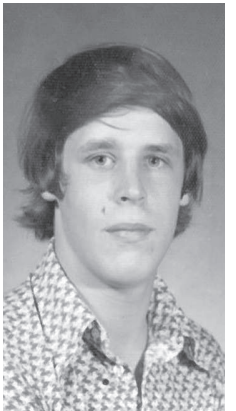
Steve Hughes 1956-2018
