On Thursday, Nov. 22, (Thanksgiving Day) at 9:23 p.m., South Lane Fire Department (SLFD), Goshen-Pleasant Hill Fire Department,

Lane County Jail on arson charges.

The investigation is still on going.

Dexter Fire Department, and Eugene-Springfield Fire Department responded to the Super 8 Motel located at 345 Oregon Ave., in Creswell for a fire.

Upon arrival, the fire was discovered and extinguished.

Two days later on Saturday, Nov. 24, at 1:42 a.m., a fire was reported at the same location. The fire departments again responded and extinguished the fire.

Due to the suspicious nature of the fires, the Oregon State Police Arson Unit was requested to assist in the investigation. Arson detectives responded and led a joint Origin and Cause Investigation with the South Lane Fire Department and Lane County Sheriff's Office.

The fire was determined to be incendiary and intentionally set.

Following an investigation, detectives learned
