Boating safety reminders

Winter storms and high water also mean that you can count on downed trees creating obstructions to navigation on our statewide "liquid highways." The Marine Board wants to remind boaters about key safety measures when the water is high and full of debris:

- High water can impact the visibility of aids to navigation (ATONs) and other waterway markers. Please use aids with caution.
- Scout river runs and have a float plan. Make sure family and friends know where you're boating and when you expect to return.
- Make sure all of your equipment and emergency

gear is good condition. Mechanical issues contribute to accidents and lack of communication equipment such as a VHF-marine radio, Personal Locator Beacon (PLB), or even cell phone can lead to timely delays if rescue is needed.

- Extreme caution should also be taken during launching and retrieving due to high volumes of marine debris (logs, strainers, garbage, etc.). Boaters need to start out slow and keep an extra sharp lookout for floating and partially submerged debris to avoid damaging their boats. Look for subtle changes in the water's surface and the water dynamics ahead. Be prepared to portage around log jams.
- Currents are also very strong, adding to the complexity of wind or tide impacts to the movement of your boat. Anchoring is particularly challenging with a strong current.

ODFW seeks candidates for Fish Restoration and Enhancement Board

SALEM, Ore – The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife is seeking qualified applicants to fill two soon to be vacant positions on the Fish Restoration and Enhancement (R&E) Program Board. Interested individuals must apply by March 31, 2019. One position represents sport fishing interests and the other represents salmon troll fishing interests on the R&E Board.

The ideal Sport Fishing Representative will be a resident of Oregon that is able to effectively represent the sport anglers of Oregon. Desirable attributes include involvement with local fishing groups or fish management, previous experience with boards or commissions, and knowledge of, or involvement

with, the diverse sport fisheries across Oregon.

The ideal Troll Fishing Representative will be a resident of Oregon that is able to effectively represent individuals involved in Oregon's troll fisheries. Desirable attributes include involvement with local fishing groups or fish management, previous experience with boards or commissions, and knowledge of, or involvement with, the salmon troll fisheries in Oregon. Individuals who may not be directly involved in harvest but are somehow associated with the salmon troll fishery in Oregon may also apply.

The Fish Restoration and Enhancement Program was created by the Oregon Legislature in 1989 to help fund fish restoration and enhancement projects throughout the state. The program is funded by a surcharge on sport and commercial fishing licenses and commercial poundage fees and is overseen by a seven-member citizen board made up of three sport fishing representatives, three representatives from the troll, gillnet and seafood processing industries and one public-at-large representative. The Board reviews grant proposals from various organizations and agencies for funding.

Board members, who are appointed to four-year terms by the Oregon Fish and Wildlife Commission, meet three or four times each year in various communities throughout the state to review project funding applications, hear public testimony, act as liaisons between the program and the public, and to conduct other program business. Board members are volunteers; however, Board-related business expenses are reimbursed.
