Cottage Theatre to host ‘Move Out Yard Sale’ May 4

The Cottage Theatre will hold a “Move Out Yard Sale” on Saturday, May 4, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

The sale will take place in the theatre’s parking lot (weather permitting) at 700 Village Drive in Cottage Grove. In the event of rain, the sale will move indoors. This one-day sale will include furniture, appliances, props, costumes and a variety of miscellaneous items. No early sales will be permitted. All funds will go to support the theatre’s upcoming construction project.

“During summer 2019, we’ll be remodeling the theatre to add 50 seats and make a variety of technical and safety up-grades,” said Cottage Theatre Executive Director Susan Goes. “Because we will be retrofitting our building with fire sprinklers, we need to clear out all of our costumes, props and equipment this spring and move them all back in this fall. It’s the perfect time to clean house and winnow our collections.”

Much of the theatre’s inventory will be moving to temporary storage over the summer, but items no longer needed will be included in this yard sale.

The theatre will continue its 2019 season in October, post-construction, with The Complete Works of William Shakespeare (abridged)[Revised], a zany, side-splitting romp through 37 plays in 97 minutes.
