The community of Cottage Grove is invited to attend this open house and to celebrate the beginning

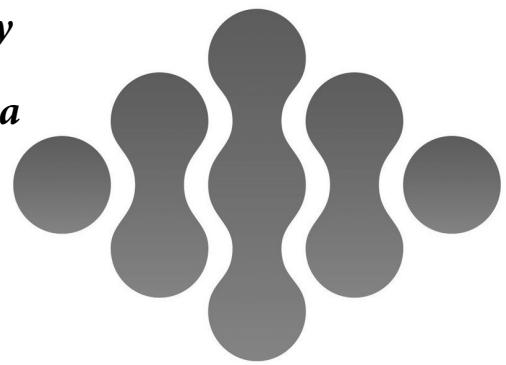
of this service to the public. The open house will be from 1 to 3 p.m.
