This was the 8<sup>th</sup> year of the Gran Fondo in Cottage Grove and for the first time, we saw significant engagement from local businesses. In past years, there have been many complaints that the road being closed downtown hurts Main Street business activity on the day of the event. Those complaints were valid and organizations like the Chamber of Commerce, Main Street Program, EBID (Economic and Business Improvement District) and Travel Lane County have been listening. We worked hard to address everyone's concerns and we think this year was a dramatic improvement over past vears.
