• A male border collie mix missing its rear left

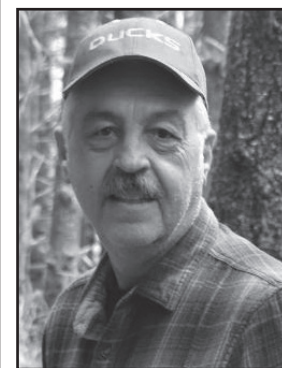
leg was found on 22nd Street was brought to the police station. No collar or microchip were found on the animal.

County to present Sears Road revision update

Lane County staff will be presenting a revised recommendation to the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) on Tuesday, Sept. 10.

Based on public comments and the parameters of the grant funding, staff has revised the recommendation to:

1) Significantly reduce the number of trees recommended for removal from 60 to six trees within the right-of-way; and

2) Add centerline rumble strips on Sears Road.

The Sept. 10 meeting is not a public hearing, but public comments are always welcome at 9 a.m.

The meeting is held in Harris Hall at the Lane County Public Service Building, 125 E. Eighth Ave., in Eugene.

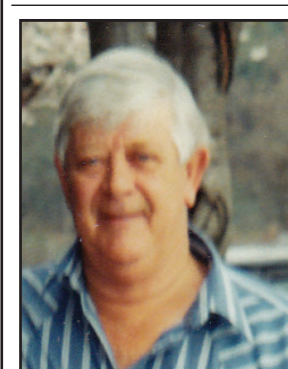
