Native Tree Walk at ECEC Oct. 11

Oregon State University Extension Service of Douglas County will offer a class on native tree identification on Friday, October 11, 2019 from 10am to 1pm. The Native Tree Walk will be held at the Elkton Community Education Center (ECEC). Their 4.5-acre botanical garden includes the seven climate zones of Oregon and the typical native trees that might be found in each region.

Tree identification is more than just knowing what you have planted in the back yard. Learn what trees are native to Oregon and what makes them well suited for certain areas. Your ability to properly care for your native trees can only be enhanced by learning about what you've got. This

workshop will give you all the tricks of the trade to identify the native trees in Douglas County – even the look-a-likes!

The Native Tree Walk will be held October 11 from 10 a.m. to approximately 1 p.m. at the Elkton Community Education Center (ECEC). The instructor is Alicia Christiansen, Douglas County Extension Forester. The cost is \$25 per couple and includes a copy of the book *Trees to Know in Oregon* (cost is \$10 per couple without the book). The ECEC is a wonderful facility and is well worth your time.

- From Eugene go south on I-5 to exit 162 and follow Hwy 38 west to Elkton

- From Reedsport take Hwy 38 east to Elkton

- From Roseburg go north on I-5 to exit 136 and take Hwy 138 west to Elkton

- The Education Center is approximately 2 miles west of Elkton on the south side of the highway (on the left traveling from Elkton and on the right traveling from Reedsport).
