The Y offers the opportunity for children to continue to grow and learn in a safe, healthy environment, providing mentorship, healthy snacks and creative programming on a daily basis.

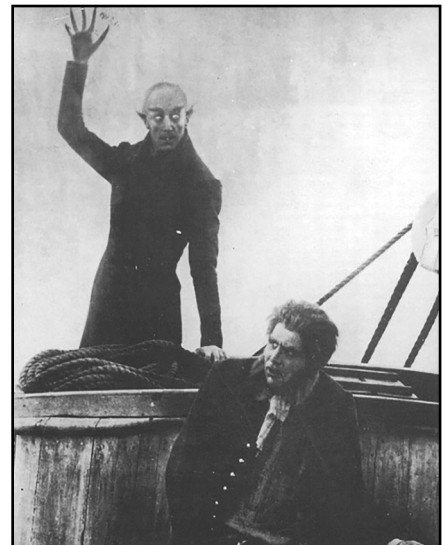

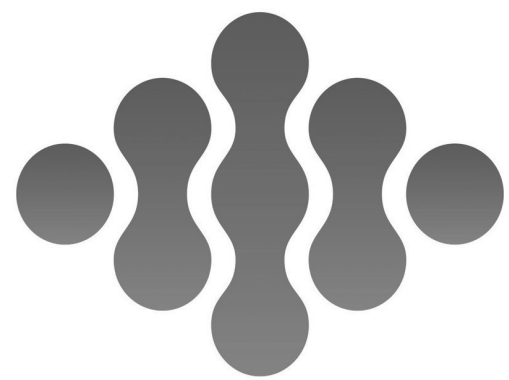
p.m., and Saturday, Oct. 19, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
