move to where I grew up and spend more time with the family was too much to turn down,” said Roberts in an email to the CGHS coaches.

In January, Roberts announced that he was stepping down from the role of head coach after 11 seasons at the helm. The five-time Sky-Em Coach of the Year left as the winningest coach in school history, which includes the 2017 state title.

4. April 24, 2019: “Derrick’s no-hitter guides Warriors to win”. On Monday night, Nicki Derrick was unhittable.

In a playoff-esque road game against 15th ranked Oakland (9-2, 5-1 Special District 3), Derrick led the third-ranked Warriors (15-1, 8-0 Special District 3) to a 1-0 victory as she struck out 20 batters on her way to a no-hitter.

All season the junior pitcher — who struck out a staggering 57 percent of the batters she faced, recorded six no hitters and two perfect games — was dominant

against everyone. But especially against the best teams North Douglas faced. In the regular season, it was this no-hitter against Oakland and a pair of shutouts against Central Linn, two of the best teams in the league.

5. May 22, 2019: “Krokus crowned state champion”. Friday’s state triple jump competition was over as soon as Mitchell Krokus started.

Competing at Mt. Hood Community College, the Cottage Grove junior was able to claim the state title by recording the farthest jump of the day – a mark of 44-04.75 feet – on his very first jump of the competition.

“I’m still kind of processing. It’s weird,” said Krokus who recorded the three farthest jumps in the competition. “It’s a relief but also like something to look forward to next season. It’s something I want to keep improving. It usually takes a few hours to kick in.”

Krokus will look to defend his title in 2020 with track and field starting up

again in March.

6. May 22, 2019: “Olson takes discus title, Byle to finals in three events”. It was a long day — made longer by a 76-minute thunder and lightning delay — for Elkton junior Sadie Olson and sophomore Margaret Byle at last Saturday’s 1A state track meet.

On the final day of competition, the pair of athletes made the finals in all five of their respective events – Olson in discus and shot put

and Byle in the 100, 200 and 400 – highlighted by Olson finishing the day with a state discus title.

“I had never expected this. Coming my freshman year I scratched all my throws at districts. But last year when I came and got second place [at state] I was like, ‘Wow, I might actually get first next year once this girl graduates,’” said Olson. “So I’m just overjoyed and I’m really glad. And I’m really thankful it didn’t get cancelled.”

7. June 5, 2019: “Warriors take softball state title”. With what seemed like the entire community of Drain watching in the stands, the North Douglas softball team put on a show during Friday’s state championship.

“I tell ya, I would say most of Drain showed up for the game today. We had so many fans here, it was fantastic,” said North Douglas head coach Jesse Rice. “And I’m sure they’re going to follow us all the way home and give us no rest for about a week. I mean, the community is fired up and they should be because it was a really, really good performance by these girls.”

The ninth-seeded Warriors (28-3) gave their fans plenty to cheer about at Jane Sanders Stadium as

the team, in front of a crowd of 1,107 people, claimed its second softball state title in the last three seasons with a 15-6 win over defending champions and seventh seed Kennedy (22-5).

8. July 31, 2019: “Local students put CG wrestling on the map”. While the high school season officially ended in February,
