The Boy Scouts of America was incorporated February 8, 1910 Under the laws of the District of Columbia. Thirty-four national representatives of boys' work agencies met, June 21. They met in a temporary national headquarters in a YMCA office in New York and developed organization plans.

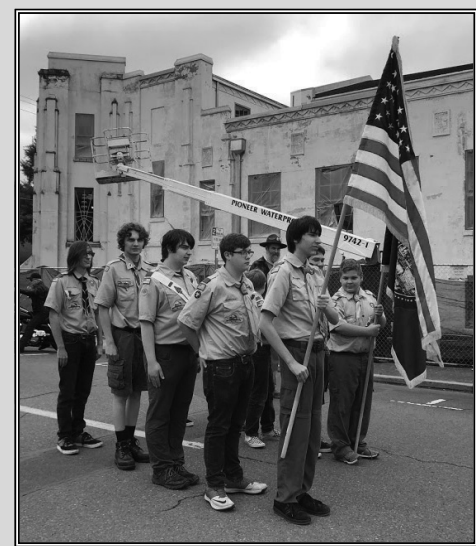
Pack & Troop 140 Volunteering efforts include:
