Police make arrest in attempted robbery at local Dairy Queen

On Sunday, Feb. 16, the Cottage Grove Police Department received a report of a robbery in progress at a local Dairy Queen restaurant, 714 Highway 99, at approximately 8:30 p.m.

While officers were responding, they were advised that the suspect was wearing a mask and was armed with a gun.

Officers arrived to find a Dairy Queen employee engaged in a physical

fight with the suspect, who was later identified as Ryan Stephen Howard.

Two other employees had fled the building after the robber confronted staff.

Officers fought with

the suspect briefly before taking him into custody. Howard was transported to the Cottage Grove Police Department and then to the Lane County Jail.

Howard was charged

with Robbery in the Second Degree; Burglary in the Second Degree; Assault 4; Menacing; Resisting Arrest; Interfering with Police; and Harassment.

This case (No. 2020-

0370) was still under investigation as of press time and more information will be released at the conclusion of the CGPD's investigation.

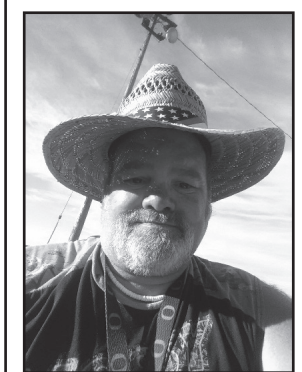
Mary Thornton Pflieger December 29, 2019
