Keith enjoyed four wheeling, driving across the state to play in the snow, mud, or sand. He was also a well-known and was a very talented mechanic. He was known

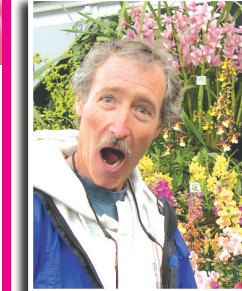
