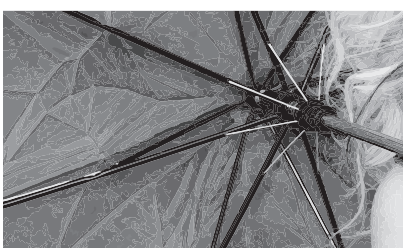

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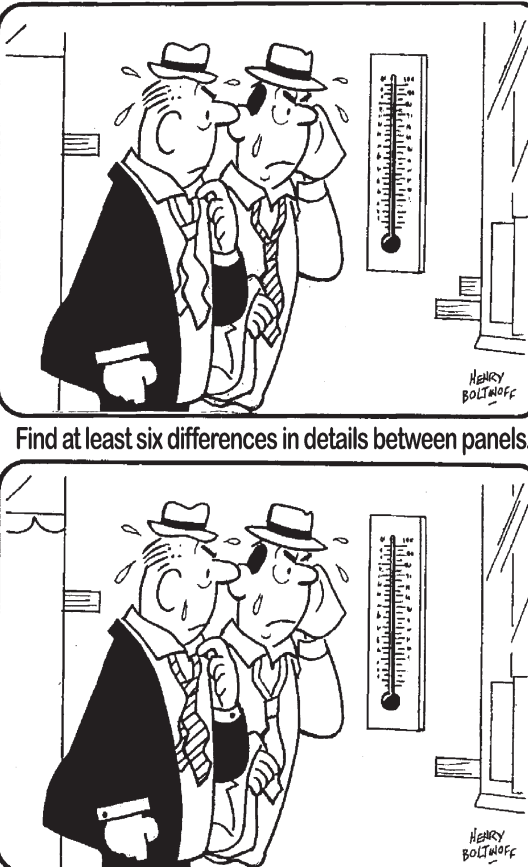
Even Exchange by Donna Pettman

Answer: Too much coffee will give you SLEEPLESSNESS, the word we're looking for.

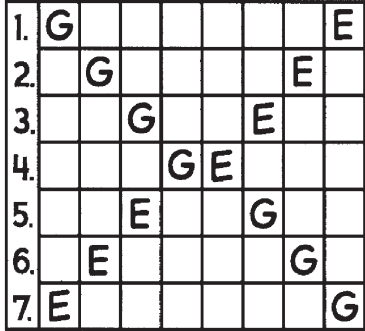

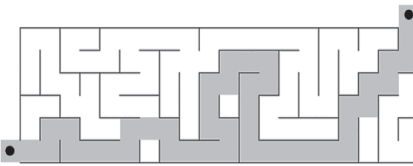

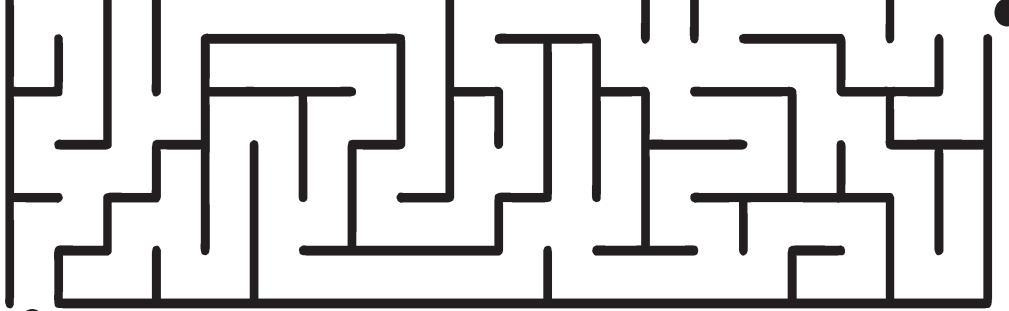
