- Suggest they can get a tax refund or economic impact payment faster by working on the taxpayer's behalf. This scam could be conducted by person.

> Taxpayers should look out for phishing emails asking them to verify their personal information in order to receive an economic stimulus check from the government. While talk of economic stimulus checks has been in the news cycle, government agencies are not sending unsolicited emails seeking taxpayers' private information in order to send them money. Phishing emails may also claim to be related to: Charitable contributions, general financial relief, airline carrier refunds, fake cures and vaccines, as well as fake testing kits.
