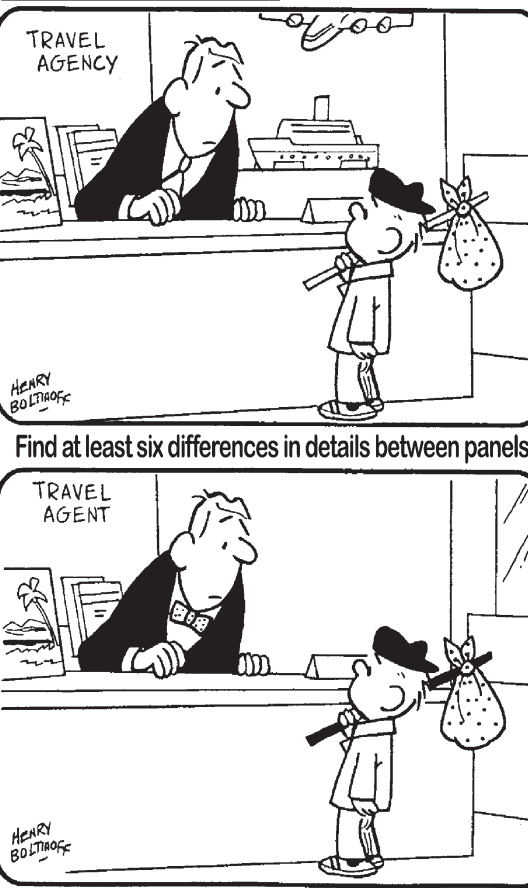

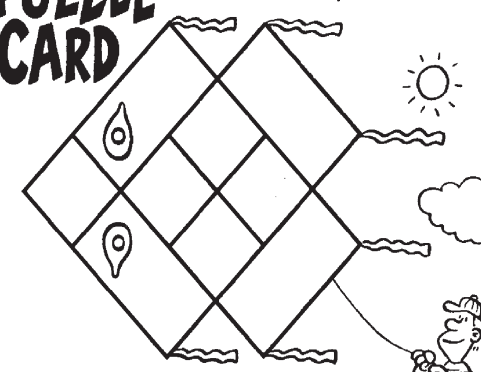

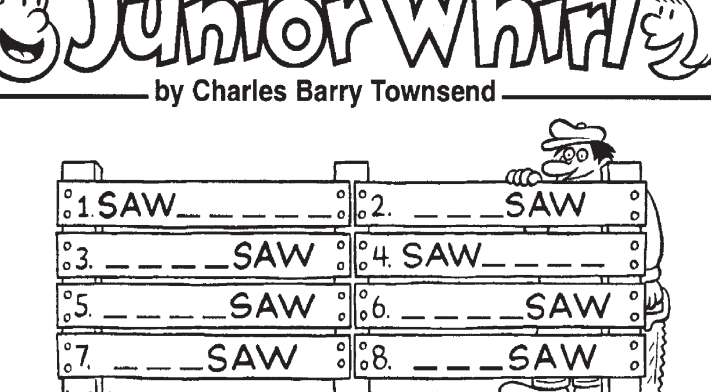
PUZZLE CARD

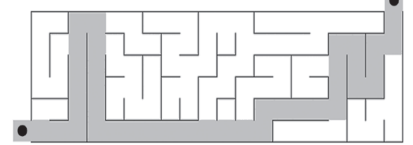

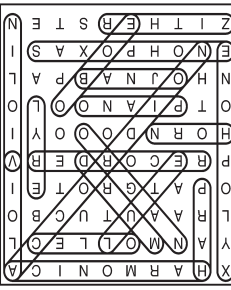

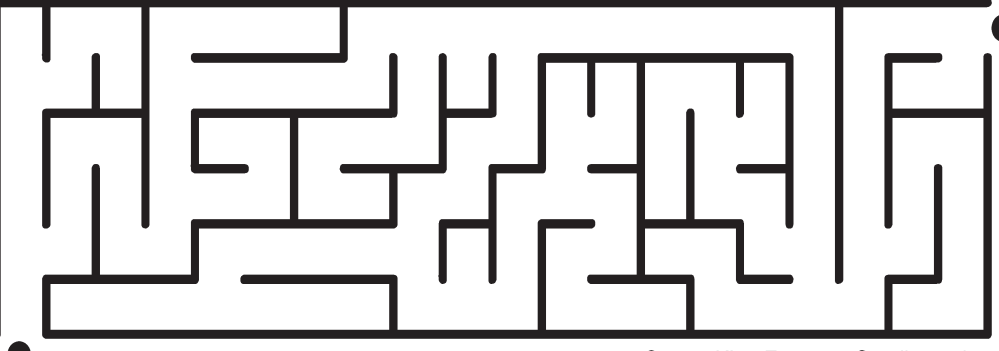
