

Lane County services modified to assure social distancing

As Lane County continues to respond to COVID-19, county offices have made adjustments to how and when some services are available to the public.

These changes are intended to help safeguard the health of the people it serves, as well as the health of its employees.

A few key services that are typically in demand this time of year have made changes that allow them to continue operating, including:

- **Assessment & Taxation:** Limited in-person customer service hours will be held through May 15, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., leading up to the May 15 third trimester property tax payment due date.

Assessment & Taxation has also increased alter-

native payment options, including online payments or payments over the phone (1-833-819-5119).

Checks can also be mailed or placed in the Assessment & Taxation lobby drop box during normal business hours.

Changes were made to better protect customers during in-person visits, including sneeze guards at the payment and information counters and installation of a lobby phone for customers who wish to make phone payments on-site.

vised Statutes (ORS), and the State Legislature has not made any changes to those dates.

- **Elections:** While the Elections Office is closed to walk-ins, services are available online and by phone. If an issue cannot be resolved over the phone, an appointment will be made.

State Fire Marshal extends self-serve gas rules change to May 23

The Office of the State Fire Marshal (OSFM) is extending its temporary rules change allowing Oregon gas retailers to provide self-service on a voluntary basis, in order to address worker short-

ages at stations statewide. May 8, State Fire Marshal Jim Walker extended the deadline from May 9 to May 23.

“We want to thank Oregonians and Oregon businesses for adjusting

how they fuel up their vehicles and serve customers with this extension of rules suspension, which allows for self-service at Oregon gas stations,” said Walker.

Station operators will

continue to have flexibility to manage their operations and ensure refueling is safe for customers and service station attendants, while keeping stations open as COVID-19 impacts fueling stations’

workforce.

This extension of the self-service rules change does not impact areas of the state that are already authorized for self-service refueling under state law.

“Sponsors have provided 10 tiny homes to Lane County for use by homeless individuals who need to be isolated or quarantined,” the county wrote.

Recently, the coun-

ty has also purchased a property with 40 rooms that can be used for isolation. The facility is expected to be ready to open on May 15.

In addition, Lane County manages the local clearinghouse that is used to support health-care providers in the

event of a surge. There are currently 216,350 procedure masks, 48,452 N-95 respirators, 12,576 gowns, 265,244 gloves and 5,949 face masks.

“We are committed to the health and safety of our residents and all Oregonians; therefore we have put together a

blueprint that will guide us in monitoring the spread of COVID-19 and outlines our plan to adhere to state guidance

on Phase 1,” the county wrote. “Should data and conditions indicate a need, we are prepared to re-impose physical dis-

tancing measures either county-wide or in affected areas.”
